Domaine St. Pierre Brut N/V

6/32

From New Mexico, this sparkling wine is a blend of pinot noir, chardonnay and meunier. It is fruit forward with tones of grapefruit, biscuit and a dry, tart finish.

Whites

2010 Sierra Cruz Sauvignon Blanc

6/24

From the Maule Valley in Chile, this wine has hints of grapefruit, citrus and also has a slight effervescence.

2010 Ancora Pinot Grigio

6/24

From the Lombardia region of Northern Italy, this is a fresh, dry and delicate wine with floral and citrus notes.

2009 Wildfire Chardonnay

7/28

This unoaked wine from California has tropical fruit aromas and ripe varietal flavors balanced by crisp acidity.

2009 Martin Codax Albariño

10/39

A staff favorite from Rias Baixas, Spain, this wine has hints of citrus fruit, pears and ripe peaches.

2009 Keuka Lake Vignoles

9/34

Vignoles is a grape developed in the late 19th Century. It is "gently dry" while maintaining a fruity, minerally taste. From the Finger Lakes region of New York.

2010 Hi Def Riesling

7/28

Sweet with bright acids, this German Riesling from the Mosel Valley starts off with a nose of peaches and white flowers then finishes with hints of citrus and a nice minerality.

Reds

2010 Angeline Pinot Noir

10/39

A red, dark brick color with intense aromas of black cherry highlighted by smoke and sweet, earthy spice. Fresh, ripe flavors with soft tannins and a light, easy finish. Grapes sourced from Sonoma, Mendocino and Santa Barbara.

2008 Red Wire Red Blend

7/28

A true "kitchen sink" blend of grenache, syrah, zinfandel, petite sirah and white grenache from Napa Valley. This wine offers up notes of blackberries, blueberries and cinnamon.

2009 Ray's Station Merlot

9/34

A structured and herbal wine from Sonoma County. A small amount (2%) of cabernet sauvignon is blended in to enhance the structure. Lots of spicy plum, black cherry and cassis with a lingering, smoky finish.

2010 Stephen Vincent Crimson

8/32

75% syrah and 25% cabernet, this Sonoma County wine has flavors of dark berries, dark chocolate and a black tea mineral essence.

2008 Shannon Ridge Wrangler Red

7/28

A blend of zinfandel, syrah, petite sirah, mourvèdre and tempranillo from Lake County, California results in a dark garnet-colored wine with rich oak, cherry notes and good tannin structure.

2009 Hullabaloo Zinfandel

9/34

This old vines zinfandel (some planted before 1892) has classic characteristics of cracked pepper, raspberries and black cherries. This Lodi wine is aged in American oak for 14 months.

2010 Boom Boom Syrah

10/39

A fruit bomb from Charles Smith, this Washington State syrah is blended with 8% mourvèdre. It is dark and inky with a plush texture. Flavors of dark fruit, tobacco, baking spices and vanilla.

2010 Twenty Bench Cabernet Sauvignon

13/48

The 10th anniversary vintage for Nine North Wine Company in Napa, this complex wine has flavors of cigar box, cassis and dark chocolate. Lots of length on the palate with good structure and silky tannins.

<i>Hints of toast and bread dough accent lightly honeyed flavors of quince, apple blossom and peach.</i>

2009 Foris Pinot Gris	Illinois Valley, Oregon	32
<i>The winery location (SW Oregon) puts an Alpine twist on the flavors - lemon, pineapple, lime and just a touch of honey.</i>		
2010 Terrapin Cellars Pinot Gris	Willamette Valley, Oregon	34
<i>Sustainably-grown with bright citrus flavors that finish with a creamy, lush texture and honeysuckle notes.</i>		
2009 Peter Franus Carneros Sauvignon Blanc	Carneros, California	44
<i>Pale yellow in color and dry on the palate with notes of ginger, lemongrass and lime. A very complex and refreshing wine.</i>		
2010 Elk Cove Pinot Gris	Willamette Valley, Oregon	39
<i>Fermented in stainless steel, this bargain has notes of melon and grapefruit and has a full, round finish.</i>		
2009 Patricia Green Sauvignon Blanc	Oregon	60
<i>Mandarin, lime and grapefruit notes with a distinct finish of pear in yet another fantastic release from this legendary winemaker.</i>		
2010 Tangent Ecclestone	San Luis Obispo County, California	37
<i>This is a complex blend of white grapes inspired by the wines in the Alsace region of France. Pinot grigio, viognier, riesling, pinot blanc, muscat and albariño make up this crisp, off-dry stunner.</i>		
2010 Horton Viognier	Gordonsville, Virginia	32
<i>Intense floral aromas along with exotic melon flavors that make this a crisp, full-bodied wine with a long, complex finish.</i>		
2009 L'Ecole No. 41 Chardonnay	Washington State	51
<i>Barrel fermented in the traditional burgundian style. Robust natural acidity, tropical flavors and a slight mineral edge provide complexity and balance.</i>

2009 Jigsaw Pinot Noir	Willamette Valley, Oregon	42
<i>A blend from both organic and conventionally farmed vineyards, aromatics of raspberry and currants open to velvety tannins.</i>		
2010 Patricia Green Reserve Pinot Noir	Willamette Valley, Oregon	55
<i>It has bright fruit flavors and is silky on the palate. A simply beautiful wine.</i>		
2009 Meiomi Belle Glos Pinot Noir	California	65
<i>Hints of black tea and black cherry on the nose with flavors of star anise and cola on the medium-long finish.</i>		
2009 Matello "Lazarus" Pinot Noir	Willamette Valley, Oregon	59
<i>Only 396 cases produced, this wine very light in color, but has surprisingly fleshy tannins (due to being made by 35% whole grape clusters) and a well-layered and complex body. Aged in older oak barrels for 11 months.</i>		
2009 MacMurray Ranch Pinot Noir	Sonoma Coast, California	39
<i>Elegant fruit character with rich aromas and flavors of raspberry, cherry, red currant and hints of mushroom.</i>		
2010 Velvet Devil Merlot	Walla Walla, Washington	36
<i>A Charles Smith wine. Smooth-drinking with hints of milk chocolate, cinnamon and blackberries.</i>		
2009 Santa Barbara ZCS	Santa Barbara, California	30
<i>Old vine zinfandel (60%) carignane (24%) and sangiovese (16%) produce jammy fruit qualities and black currant flavors here.</i>		
2010 Charles and Charles Cabernet/Syrah	Columbia Valley, Washington	36
<i>51% oaked cabernet sauvignon is blended with 49% unoaked syrah. Dark chocolate overtones with a blueberry finish.</i>		
2010 Laurel Glen "REDS"	Lodi, California	32
<i>This blend of zinfandel, carignane and petite syrah makes a spicy, dark wine that drinks well with a nice, tannic finish.</i>		
2009 Uppercut Cabernet Sauvignon	Napa Valley, California	54
<i>Smooth black cherry and cocoa flavors expand across the palate, revealing caramel and toffee from new oak barrels.</i>		
2006/2007 Reserve Lava Cap Cabernet Sauvignon	California	45
<i>Soft tannins and hints of tobacco, leather, blackberry, anise make this matured cabernet robust and savory.</i>		
2008 Sanctuary Cabernet Sauvignon	Napa Valley, California	66
<i>Complex and rich, this wine offers a wealth of black currant, blackberry and cedar flavors wrapped into softly firm tannins.</i>		
2007 Ramey Cabernet Sauvignon	Napa Valley, California	91
<i>Dark berries, plums and hints of mocha and vanilla oak. Smooth mouthfeel and complex tannins. Drinking well now.</i>		
2009 Foxglove Zinfandel	Paso Robles, California	38
<i>Blended with 6 % petite syrah, this wine has deep plum, blackberry and baking spice tones that are most prominent.</i>		
2007 Reserve Lava Cap Zinfandel	California	48
<i>This full bodied zinfandel displays strong notes of berry and spices, as well as hints of black pepper and chocolate.</i>		
2008 Spann Vineyards "Mo Zin"	California	47
<i>31% zinfandel, 25% mourvedre, 24% petite sirah, 16% primitive & 4% syrah. A great base of raspberry and blackberry with a rich backbone. This is a Rhone-inspired blend that is velvety and has round tannins and an enjoyable, long finish.</i>		
2007 Ramey Syrah	Sonoma Coast, California	71
<i>Big, jammy fruit and hints of white and black pepper. A classic California syrah.</i>		
2006 Peter Franus Red	Napa Valley, California	94
<i>70% cabernet, 20% merlot and 10% cab franc. Flavors of cherry tobacco, vanilla, coffee bean, smoky meats and currant.</i>		
2009 Jaffurs Petite Sirah	Santa Barbara, California	74
<i>Dark in color, powerful in taste and a fantastic stick-to-your-lips quality. Think of a deep, rich blackberry tart.</i>
